RESERVE SAINT MICHEL GRENACHE BLANC £3.80 £5.10 £16.00  
VIN DE PAYS D'OC, FRANCE

Crisp, clean, dry wine. Well bodied with a good finish. Can be drunk by itself, or enjoy with white meat or seafood.

POKER FACE CHARDONNAY, AUSTRALIA £3.70 £5.10 £15.00

A fruit driven nose of lychee and pomegranate with definite lime characteristics. The lively palate has good fruit flavour balanced by soft, subtle oak and fresh acidity with a long lasting and satisfying finish. Great with seafood.

LA PALMA SAUVIGNON BLANC, CHILE £3.70 £5.10 £15.00

Refreshingly crisp, light bodied and dry with a delicate aroma of gooseberries with a mineral edge. An attractive style with bags of classic, invigorating characteristics rarely seen in Chilean Sauvignons and a long, persistent finish. A superb aperitif.

RIEBEEK CELLARS CHENIN BLANC, SOUTH AFRICA £3.70 £5.10 £15.00

Produced from old bush vines with low yields, harvested at optimum ripeness. Fermented with specially selected yeast adding to the complexity and mouth feel of this style of Chenin Blanc. Matches poultry very well.

MARQUES DEL ATRIO BLANCO RIOJA, SPAIN £15.00

Very dry, clean, fresh and aromatic with plenty of tangy acidity and a long complex finish. Great with many types of tapas.

PINOT GRIGIO VILLA CERRO VENETO, ITALY £3.90 £5.50 £15.50

Uncomplicated Pinot Grigio with fresh, floral fruit and a crisp dry finish. A very solid all-rounder, but best as an aperitif.

RICHLAND VIOGNIER, AUSTRALIA £17.00

Straw yellow in colour with a green hue and displays a fragrant nose of apricot, orange blossom and musk. The full bodied palate is fruity, rich and luscious and true to the varietal with flavours of sweet peach, apricot nectar and spice. The finish is dry, soft and round with a warm finish. Great with pasta.

GAVI ANTARIO GAVI DOCG, PIEMONTE, ITALY £16.50

A medium bodied, flavoursome dry white wine with elegant mineral characters and ripe citrus fruit flavours. Great with pasta.

GROVE MILL MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC £18.50  
NEW ZEALAND

The nose is herbaceous with hints of lime, honeysuckle and floral notes. A touch of the fruit cocktail to it with, rich, tropical fruit flavours. Good for seafood.

CHABLIS DOMAINE DE VAUROUX, BURGUNDY, FRANCE £23.00

Hint of green in colour, enhanced by a crisp acidity. Stylish example of white burgundy. Buttery richness and a full flavoured finish mean this wine matches richer dishes best.

SANCERRE DOMAINE DE DURAND, LOIRE, FRANCE £19.50

Flinty and fruity, from the Sauvignon grape. Wonderful nose, with all the classic flavours that follows. From a small producer whose emphasis is on the quality. Best with fish.

CHATEAU MUSAR 2004, LEBANON £39.00

Exotic hints of cedar and liquorice beautifully complemented by the sweet, fruity palate, delicious savoury notes and soft tannins. Great with red meat.

CHATEAU TEYSSIER SAINT EMILION GRAND CRU  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE £35.00

We have listed this wine for many years now, and have never been disappointed. Smooth, blackcurrant fruit gives it a great mouth-feel and help it accompany pork or lamb dishes.

DEVIL'S CORNER TASMANIA PINOT NOIR, AUSTRALIA £19.50

This wine is made as a lighter bodied style but there is no shortage of flavour backed up with fine, silky tannins and a long supple finish. Crafted from 100% pinot noir from the Tamar Valley vineyards in Northern Tasmania. This vintage was warm, dry and sunny providing excellent ripeness with deep bright colours and full fruit flavours. A great alternative to Red Burgundy.

COTES DU RHONE DOMAINE LE GARRIGON, FRANCE £17.50

More Syrah than Grenache with an array of berries, brambles and spice. Great with red meats.

## Champagne & Sparkling

PROSECCO, ITALY £22.00

Crystal clear with aromas of peach, citrus and tropical fruits.

DUMONT MOUSSEUX BRUT, FRANCE £17.00

Fresh and lively on the nose, with good fruit and persistent length.

COLLET BRUT CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE £35.00

Unusually, the Pinot Meunier grape, which is normally only present in small quantities in modern Champagne blends, is in the majority here. (65% Pinot Meunier, 25% Pinot Noir and 10% Chardonnay). Golden in colour, robust and well structured with a long finish. It has a minimum of 3 years of cellaring before being shipped.

POL ROGER BRUT RESERVE CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE £45.00

Floral and soft in extreme youth, the Pinot Noir soon reveals itself in a firm yet creamy structure, with plenty of zesty fruit and true depth.

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
